15th APG Annual Meet was organized by the Institute for Spatial Planning and Environment Research, Panchkula, Haryana as 2nd APG and 5th ISPER International Seminar from 28-30 November. 2014 on "Rediscovering Traditions of Folk, Place and work in Sustainable Settlement Planning". Sh. Digvijay Singh Hon'ble M.P. Rajya Sabha and former C.M. of Madhya Pradesh was the Chief Guest. A total of 118 delegates from 12 States and UTs namely Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Rajasthan, Jammu and Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, U.P., Rajasthan, Maharashtra and West Bengal got registered at the conference.
